SUGGESTED WORDING:

The First Peoples First Cultural Foundation recommends the following wording be placed in your Will, although it is recommended that you speak to a financial adviser and/or lawyer when making your Will.

Wording for making an **Unrestricted Bequest**

I bequeath to First Peoples First Cultural Foundation Incorporated, for the general purpose of the said organisation and free of all duties and taxes, the following:

1. Percentage % of my estate
2. The whole of my estate
3. All the residue of my estate, including personal property
4. Percentage: ...% of the residue of my estate
